## **Directions adopted on 5 November 2010 by the Administrative Tribunal**

The Administrative Tribunal,

In view of facilitating the procedure and the hearings,

Adopts the following Directions:

1. In addition to requirements set out in Rules IX, X, XI, XII and XIII of the Rules of Procedure, the parties shall number the entire pleading from the first page in continuous numerical order, including annexes.
2. The parties shall include an index of all attached documents with their corresponding page numbers, as they appear in the pleading.
3. In addition to his/her counsel or other representative, the Applicant may, at his/her request, personally intervene during the hearings.
4. The presentation by the Applicant and the Respondent's answer at the hearing shall be for a maximum of one hour and thirty minutes each.
5. The time granted for the Applicant's reply to the Respondent's answer and for the Respondent's rejoinder to the Applicant's reply shall be for a maximum thirty minutes each.
6. These Directions abrogate all provisions of the previous Directions dated 11 November 2009, 30 November 2006, 5 December 2001 and 27 November 2000.
7. These Directions will come into force on 1 January 2011.
