



Appointment of a Member to the Roster of Experts of the Independent Review Mechanism of the African Development Bank Group

The Independent Review Mechanism (IRM) of the African Development Bank Group has been established in 2004 to respond to complaints from people who allege that they are likely to be adversely affected by a project financed by the Bank Group due to non-compliance with the Bank's policies and procedures. The IRM responds to these complaints through problem solving and/or compliance reviews. The IRM Roster of Experts consists of three members appointed by the Bank Group's Boards of Directors on a five year non-renewable term to work on part time basis in Independent Compliance Review Panels established to investigate alleged non compliance issues and possible harm caused. Applications for the position of a member of the IRM Roster of Experts are invited from individual experts/consultants.

The incumbent shall have demonstrated independence and integrity; relevant and solid academic background (minimum Masters degree, preferably PhD) with practical experience in development, particularly in environmental, social, economics, and legal issues applicable in the public and/or private sector fields; and extensive experience in the field of compliance review with the ability to deal thoroughly and fairly in undertaking his/her duties and responsibilities.
