The Republic of Mozambique has received a loan from the African Development Bank in the amount of UA 10 millions towards the cost of the Education IV Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds of the loan to cover eligible payments under the contracts for the supply of Equipment and Related Services to Angoche Secondary School at Nampula Province . Bidding is open to all bidders from eligible member countries as defined in the ADB's Rules of Procedure for the Procurement of Goods and Works.
3. The Ministry of Education through the PIU/ Direcção de Planificação e Cooperação now invites sealed bids from prospective bidders for any or all of the following lots :
