This Specific Procurement Notice follows the General Procurement Notice for this project which appeared in UNDB issue No. 733 dated August 31, 2008.

The Government of Arab Republic of Egypt has received a loan from the African Development Bank (ADB) in EURO in the amount of USD 450 million, and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to cover eligible payments under the Purchase Order for the Feedwater Heaters for El Ain El Sokhna Supercritical Thermal Power Plant.

Bidding is open to all Bidders from eligible member countries as defined in the ADB's Rules of Procedure for Procurement of Goods and Works.

The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, furnishing all Plant, labor, technical and professional services, and technical assistance on-site and to perform all operations necessary and required to design, fabricate, furnish, deliver, transport to the Site, and test the Feedwater Heaters for El Ain El Sokhna Supercritical Thermal Power Plant. The scope of work includes supply of:

- Four Low Pressure closed Feedwater Heater
- Ten High Pressure Closed Feedwater Heater
- Two Deaerating Feedwater Heaters with storage tanks

East Delta Electricity Production Company (EDEPC), the beneficiary of the loan/Executing Agency, now invites sealed Bids from prospective Bidders for the above-mentioned package.

12:00 noon, in two Envelopes. Envelope A must contain all the required information, except the schedules of Quantities and Prices, and must be accompanied by a Bid Security in an acceptable form equal to USD 500,000. Envelope B must include the schedules of Quantities and Prices. Bids shall be valid for a period of 180 days after Bid opening.

Only Envelope A of Bids will be opened on the same day at 13:00 hours (Egypt local time), in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend, at the Headquarters of EDEPC at the address shown above. Bidders whose Bids have been determined to be substantially responsive shall be informed of the opening date for Envelopes B.
