Steam Turbine Generator And Condenser

This Specific Procurement Notice follows the General Procurement Notice for this project which appeared in UNDB online in May 2009.

The Government of Arab Republic of Egypt has applied for a loan from the African Development Bank (ADB) in EURO in the amount equivalent to USD 150 million, and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to cover eligible payments under the Contract for the supply and installation of Steam Turbine Generator and Condenser for Nuwaiba Power Station. Disbursement related to this contract will be subject to the approval of the loan by the ADB.

Tendering is open to all Tenderers from eligible member countries as defined in the ADB's Rules of Procedure for Procurement of Goods and Works.

The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, designing, fabricating, furnishing, testing, delivery to the site, receiving, unloading, storing, installing, training, startup, commissioning and maintaining until TOAC of one 250 MW steam turbine generator and condenser including auxiliaries and all mechanical and electrical works required for a complete operational system for Nuwaiba Power Station – 750 MW Combined Cycle Project.

East Delta Electricity Production Company (EDEPC), a wholly owned subsidiary of the Egyptian Electricity Holding Company (EEHC), the beneficiary of the loan/Executing Agency, now invites sealed Tenders from prospective Tenderers for the above-mentioned package.

Interested Tenderers are required to pay for each set of documents a non-refundable fee of US\$ 2,500.00, in local currency or its equivalent in a freely convertible currency, payable to EDEPC, National Bank of Egypt (El Ahly Bank), Ismailia Branch, account no. 11000441395). Interested eligible Tenderers may obtain further information and inspect the tendering documents at the same address.

The Tender Document for the above Package will be available at EDEPC's office on May 14, 2009. The Tender must be submitted on July 20, 2009 in two Envelopes. Envelope A must contain all the required information, except the schedules of Quantities and Prices, and must be accompanied by a Tender Security in an acceptable form equal to US\$ 1,600,000 in local currency or its equivalent in a freely convertible currency. Envelope B must include the schedules of Quantities and Prices. Tenders shall be valid for a period of 180 days after Tender opening.

Only Envelope A of Tenders will be opened on the same day at 12:00 hours (Egypt local time), in the presence of Tenderers' representatives who choose to attend, at the Headquarters of EDEPC at the address shown above. Tenderers whose Tenders have been determined to be substantially responsive shall be informed of the opening date for Envelope B.
