

**SPECIFIC PROCUREMENT NOTICE**  
**INVITATION FOR BIDS**  
**TURBI – MOYALE ROAD (A2)**

1. The Government of the Republic of Kenya has applied for a financing from the African Development Fund in various currencies towards the cost of the Mombasa – Nairobi – Addis Ababa Road Corridor Development Project Phase III - Upgrading of Turbi – Moyale Road (A2) Section. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this loan will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for the upgrading of the Turbi – Moyale Road (A2) Section.
2. The Kenya National Highways Authority (KeNHA) now invites sealed bids through International Competitive Bidding (ICB) from eligible bidders for the execution of upgrading of the Turbi – Moyale Road (A2).
