- 1.—This specific Procurement Notice follows the General Procurement Notice (GNP) for this project that appeared in UN Development Business No. 630 dated 16th May 2004.
- 2.—The Government of United Republic of Tanzania has received a loan from African Development Fund in various currencies towards the cost of support to the strategic action Plan for Vocational Educational and Training. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this loan will be applied to eligible payments under the contracts for supply and installation of Kitchen Equipment for Arusha College of Hotel and Tourism Training Centre. Bidding is open to all bidders from eligible member countries as defined in the ADB's Rules of Procedure of Goods and works.
- 3.—The Vocational Education and Training Authority (VETA) now invite sealed bids from prospective bidders for Supply and Installation of Kitchen Equipment for Arusha College of Hotel and Tourism Training Centre, Tender No VETA/ADB/09/2008. Tender must be accompanied by a bid Security Deposit of Tshs 10,000,000.00 or Its Equivalents in any Freely Convertible Currency

Interested and illegible bidders may obtain further information and inspect the bidding documents at the same address.
- 5.—The provisions in the Instructions to Bidders and in the General Conditions of Contract are the provisions of the African Development Bank *Standard Bidding Documents, Procurement* of Goods through International Competitive Bidding procedures. Bidding is open to all bidders from eligible member countries as defined in the ADB's Rule of Procedure for the Procurement of Goods and Works.
- 6.—Bids shall be valid for a period of 120 days after bid opening and must accompanied by the bid security and be delivered to, **the secretary VETA Tender Board, Chang'ombe road P.o.Box 2849 Dar es Salaam** on or before **10:00 hrs local time Monday 27th April, 2009**.
