Feasibility Study for the Rehabilitation / Reconstruction of Zefta Barrage

The Government of the Arab Republic of Egypt has received a Grant from the African Development Bank to finance the **Feasibility Study for the Rehabilitation / Reconstruction of Zefta Barrage**.

The specific Study objective is to determine the most technically viable, economically feasible, and environmental and socially acceptable option for the rehabilitation/reconstruction of Zefta Barrage, including the production of a comprehensive feasibility report and the associated engineering designs, bills of quantities and tender documents for the selected option.

The Study includes two components, namely;

- Consultancy Services for Technical Assistance to execute the Study
- Consultancy Services for Audit of the Study
