The Governments of the Republic of Malawi has received a grant from the African Water Facility (AWF), administered by the African Development Bank (AfDB), to finance a project for ‘**Strengthening Water Sector Monitoring and Evaluation**’ in the country. The project is to be implemented by the Ministry of Irrigation and Water Development (MoIWD).

The objective of the project is to ensure the availability of reliable data and information in the water sector to track the achievement of development targets, policies, programmes and projects and to facilitate decision making in planning and managing the sector.

The Project is executed the Ministry of Irrigation and Water Development in collaboration with various stakeholders in the Water and Sanitation Sector. Those activities to be contracted out include:

- Consultancy services - Technical assistance for coordination, training and development of M&E Systems;
- Goods: Vehicles, Equipment for water data generation, analysis and storage.
