This request for Expression of Interest (EOI) follows the General Procurement Notice for the project that appeared in UN Development Journal of June 2007

The Government of the Republic of The Gambia has received a grant from the African Development Fund (ADF) in the amount of UA 8.97 million towards the cost of Entrepreneurship Promotion and Micro Finance Development Project (EPMDP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds of the grant to cover eligible payments under the contracts for the recruitment of a Consultant for Entrepreneurship Assessment Study under the project. The services include:

- Assessment of existing strategy, programs and training materials
- Design strategy to ensure sustainability of SME training and coaching.
- Provide assistance to implement the strategy.
