## **Background**

It is now well known that the African region entered the new Millennium with a remarkable improvement in economic growth and performance. Nevertheless, the continent continues to face serious challenges in several key areas: trade, governance, conflicts, HIV/AIDS as well as tuberculosis and Malaria, food security, regional integration, poverty reduction etc. Against this background, the ECA and AfDB, will organize the second annual African Economic Conference (AEC) to provide a forum for exchange of ideas among economists and policymakers with a view to improving access to information and research on economic issues and, as a consequence, the quality of economic policy-making in the region.

## **Organization and Format of the Conference**

The conference is organized by the African Development Bank Group and the Economic Commission for Africa. It will be held over three days and consist of plenary as well as break-out sessions. Plenary speakers will be outstanding scholars in various fields of economics invited as special guests. Break-out sessions will be based on submitted papers.

## **Submission of Papers**

The program committee invites submission of abstracts (or papers) by interested participants on any economic issue of relevance to African economies. Only one submission per individual will be considered. Submissions must be in English or French. Although the committee encourages submissions in all areas of economics, it is particularly interested in papers that fall into the following broad areas:  
Regional Integration, Trade, Monetary and Financial Sector, Growth and Equity, Financing Development, Investment, Private Sector, Natural Resources, Asia and Africa.
