1 The Government of the Federal Republic of Nigeria has received loans and a grant from the African Development Bank, the African Development Fund and the Rural Water and Sanitation Initiative Trust Fund in the amount of UA 107.65 million (USD150.00 million), UA 71.77million (USD 100.00 million) and UA 3.99 million (USD35.56 million) respectively, to finance the Nigeria Inclusive Basic Service Delivery and Livelihood Empowerment Integrated Programme and intends to apply these loans and grant for payments of goods, works, related services and consulting services to be procured under this program.

2. The program which will be implemented by the Federal Agencies (Presidential Committee on te North East Initiative, the Office of the Vice President social investment) unit Federal Ministries of Water Resources, Health, Education, Women & Social Affairs(labor) and States (Adamawa, Bauchi, Biorno, Gombe and Taraba)will include the following components:

**Component 1: Service Delivery** consists of subcomponents as follows:

- a. Promotion of the restoration and improvement of access and utilization of basic social services in water, sanitation , health, and education;
- b. Promotion and improvement of access to and utilization of rural water supply and sanitation infrastructure and hygiene, sanitation and environmental promotion in schools and communities;
- c. Community Nutrition Support to scale up nutrition services for the most vulnerable population and
- d. Rural water and sanitation reform.

**Component II: Economic Recovery** This component focuses on the following:

- a. Upgrading selected skills acquisition and TVET centers into model centers through rehabilitation/reconstruction of infrastructure and equipment supply for practical training;
- b. Skills acquisition and entrepreneurship for unskilled youth and enhancement of productivity of existing artisans and mechanics in the informal sector;
- c. Reconstruction and development of prominent markets to revamp economic activities;
- d. Encouragement of Women Owned Enterprises through Support to cooperatives;
- e. Support to economic reintegration of IDPs and vulnerable families
- f. Unified national social registry to facilitate the targeting of national social safety nets programs

**Component III: Institutional Strengthening and Project Management:** This component shall involve Institutional strengthening of the relevant Federal Ministries and the Office of the

Vice President social investment unit in charge of the national safety nets programme and job creation coordination. The component shall also provide Project Management TA support as required on the program. This component shall contain a Performance Based Allocation made available to incentivize and reward states with outstanding results for efficient project implementation.

3. All procurement of goods, works and acquisition of consulting services will be carried out in accordance with the “Procurement Policy and Methodology for Bank Group Funded Operations” (BPM), dated October 2015 and following the provisions stated in the Financing Agreements
