Feasibility Study for an Oil Products Pipeline from Kigali to Bujumbura

1. The **East African Community** (EAC) has received a grant from the African Development Bank to finance the **Feasibility Study for an Oil Products Pipeline from Kigali to Bujumbura**
2. The principal objective of this project is to investigate the technical, economic and financial feasibility of constructing approximately 220km oil products pipeline from Kigali to Bujumbura.
3. The project includes the following components :
 - a) Technical, economic and financial feasibility studies;
 - b) Preliminary Environmental and Social Impact Assessment (ESIA) studies and Environmental Social Management Plan (ESMP);
 - c) Preparation of tender documents for recruitment of a consultant firm to carry out detailed engineering design and a detailed ESIA if the study confirms the feasibility of the proposed project; and
 - d) Preparation of the business case and propose a PPP model structure.
4. Procurement of Consultancy Services will follow the Bank's ***“Rules and Procedures for the use of Consultants (May 2008 Edition, revised July 2012)”*** which is available on the Bank’s website at <http://www.afdb.org>. Bidding documents are expected to be available in May, 2015.
