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1. This Invitation for Bids follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) for this project that appeared in UNDB online on 31st March 2017.
2. The Government of Kenya has received financing from the African Development Bank in various currencies towards the cost of Kenya Towns Sustainable Water Supply and Sanitation Program. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this loan will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for construction of Kiptogot-Kolongolo Water Supply Project.
3. The Rift Valley Water Services Board now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the execution of the above project.
4. The scope of works for the project includes but not limited to the following (*The works include construction of two different water supply systems, Mubere and Kaptega but all will be implemented under one contract*).

Mubere Water Supply System:

- Construction of intake weir on Mubere River capable of conveying approximately 4,300 m<sup>3</sup>/day;
- Construction of raw water main to WTP (4.2 km long DN 150/200 cement lined epoxy coated steel pipe);
- Construction of WTP at Soko Hewani through put approximately 4,600 m<sup>3</sup>/day;
- Construction of treated water gravity main (20 km DN 250 from WTP to Kiptuimet, 6.3 km DN 300 from Kiptuimet to Kwanza and 4.3 km DN 150 from Kiptuimet to Kolongolo - cement lined epoxy coated steel pipe);
- Construction of 1 no. Storage tank 300 m<sup>3</sup> (at Kiptuimet);
- Construction of 1 no. Storage tank 500 m<sup>3</sup> (at Kolongolo);
- Construction of 1 no. Storage tank 1000 m<sup>3</sup> (at Kwanza).

Kaptega system:

- Construction of intake from Kaptega River capable of conveying approximately 10,700 m<sup>3</sup>/day;
- Construction of raw water main to WTP (0.8 km long DN 300 cement lined epoxy coated steel pipe)

- Construction of WTP next to Kaptega Forest throughput approximately 11,000 m<sup>3</sup>/day;
  - Construction of treated water gravity main (15.2 km DN 400 from WTP to Mowlem, 1.7 km DN 300 from Mowlem to Kayos and 13.8 km DN 250 from Mowlem to Kapomboi - cement lined epoxy coated steel pipe);
  - Construction of Storage tank 1300 m<sup>3</sup> (at Kayos);
  - Construction of Storage tank 1800 m<sup>3</sup> (at Kapomboi).

  7. The provisions in the Instructions to Bidders and in the General Conditions of Contract are the provisions of the African Development Bank Standard Bidding Document: Procurement of Works.
  8. Bidders are invited for a **Pre-bid Meeting** and **Site Visit** which will take place at **Nzoia Water Services Company offices** in **Kitale town** on **4<sup>th</sup> July, 2018** at **9.00a.m (East African Time)**.
  9. Bids must be delivered to the above office on or before **12.00pm East African Time** on **31<sup>st</sup> July 2018** and must be accompanied by a security (**Unconditional Bank Guarantee**) of **KES 5,000,000 (Kenya Shillings Five Million Only)** or equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency with a bid validity period of 120 days from bid submission date.
