The Republic of Zimbabwe has received a grant from the African Development Bank Group in the amount of **UA 16.12 million** towards the cost of Capacity Building for Public Finance and Economic Management (CBPFEM) Project. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this grant to cover eligible payments under the contract for the above mentioned two tenders.
3. The Ministry of Finance & Economic Development now invites sealed bids from prospective bidders for the Supply and delivery of;

Lot 2: Printers, Photocopiers, Scanners, Shredders, Duplicating & Guillotine Machines

The provisions in the Instructions to Bidders and in the General Conditions of Contract contained in the bidding documents comply with the African Development Bank Standard Bidding Document for the Procurement of Goods. The Procurement method applicable for the bidding process shall be International Competitive Bidding (ICB).
