The method of payment will be a **cash payment to the Bank Account of Uganda Revenue Authority (URA)**.
6. The provisions in the Instructions to Bidders and in the General Conditions of Contract are the provisions of the **African Development Bank Standard Bidding Document for Procurement of Works**.
7. Bids must be delivered to the above office on or before **12:00 Noon on 12 March 2019** and must be accompanied by a security of **UGX 670,000,000= (Uganda Shillings Six**

Hundred Seventy Million Only) or an equivalent amount in a freely convertible currency in form of an Acceptable Unconditional Bank Guarantee.
