



The African Development Bank organized several events in partnership with CIF, to showcase Bank and CIF success stories and to launch new studies.

COP26 was the culmination of a year focused on immediate, urgent, large-scale climate action.

COP26 represented a key event that brings together all the major stakeholders engaged on climate change issues from across governments, private sector, and civil society, including all the Bank's main partners in the climate change domain. The Bank participated in COP26 with the aim of amplifying Africa's voice and priorities on climate change, as articulated in the African common position.
