2. OBJECTIVE

The Primary objective of the consultancy includes the Implementation of authorization checks at code level for all custom Legacy programs that are in the SAP S4 HANA environment along with the relevant documentation, testing of existing functionality to fulfil our internal Audit recommendations.

In addition, the consultants / consultancy will also implement SAP ABAP best practices to improve the performance of the existing ABAP programs, prepare documentation from the existing legacy programs, implementation of modularization technics and Exceptions logging and handling from the existing programs to meet internal quality standards.

3. SCOPE OF THE SERVICES

The consultant will undertake the following duties:

- Gather and prepare whole list of inventories of ABAP programs, Function modules, Class/Methods
 and includes which will go through the treatment for code-based authorization checks in our SAP
 S4 HANA systems.
- Implementation of **authorization checks** in the code level with use of pre-existing auth objects.
- Perform the full cycle of tests after implementing the Authorization checks at code level and make sure that the functionality is not affected.
- Perform a comprehensive analysis of the existing ABAP codebase to identify redundant, obsolete, or poorly performing code.
- Document the purpose and functionality of each program, function module, and class to understand its role within the system.
- Identify performance bottlenecks by analyzing the execution time and resource consumption of critical code sections to improve the performance of the existing ABAP codes.
- Implement robust error handlings in the current ABAP programs to handle exceptions and errors
- Implementation of application logs (SLG1 Logs) with error messages, warnings, and track of the execution steps within existing legacy ABAP programs.
- Ensure knowledge proper transfer to Bank's Staff.
- Work towards preparation of S4 ABAP coding best practices to adopt and knowledge sharing with our technical teams accordingly.
- Perform any SAP ABAP development based on users' specifications.
