- A minimum of Eight (8) years working experience in RMCs
- Excellent knowledge of Information and Technology Systems, especially as used in developing countries for statistical purposes
- Demonstrated experience in data mining and scrapping and their use for development projects
- Familiarity with and a supportive attitude towards processes of strengthening local capacities and Statistical agencies
- Expertise in field data collection, statistical analysis, and data dissemination
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Ability and willingness to travel regularly within Africa.
